Coffin Golf Club is also a very quick drive from downtown Indianapolis — just ten minutes from the State House. (Take Indiana Avenue northwest to 16th Street. Go west from 16th and cross the White River. Turn northwest on Lafayette Road and shortly after that turn north on Cold Springs Road. Follow Cold Springs Road to the golf club entrance.)
